The following pre-operative instructions are given for your benefit. It is necessary that you follow these instructions closely in order to ensure that you derive the best possible result from your surgery. If for some reason you are unable to follow the instructions, please call our office as soon as possible. Feel free to **call us with any questions** you may have regarding these instructions. **844.794.7763**

For the safety and protection of all our patients, we will not release you to a cab or Uber/Lyft driver after surgery. You must plan to have a friend or family member pick you up and drive you home.

Pre-Operative Instructions: 2+ Weeks Prior to Surgery Date:

- O Please **complete and/or update your Medical History** via our secure patient portal at least 2 weeks prior to surgery. Visit our website at www.drkuy.com Log into Patient Portal. Any problems please contact our office 844.794.7763
- O If Dr Kuy orders an EKG prior to your surgery, please schedule this test with your primary care physician or at any outpatient testing hospital. The EKG results must be received 2 weeks prior to your surgery. A current EKG within one year of surgery date may be faxed to our office. 513-827-9796
- O Any patient who has a **cardiac condition** and is being treated by a cardiologist or primary care physician, **must have approval for surgery from their doctor.** *Failure to follow these instructions could cause cancellation of your surgery.*
- O Patients must have **Blood Pressure checked** and **report faxed** to office [Walgreen, Walmart, etc.]
- O Patients who smoke should discontinue smoking for 6 weeks prior to surgery and for 3 weeks after surgery.
- O Do not take aspirin or products that contain Ibuprofen for 10 days before surgery.
 - [Bufferin, Anacin, Empirin, Stanback, Excedrin, Fiorinal, Darvon Compound, Advil, Nuprin, Medipren, Aleve, Motrin] *Panadol or Tylenol may be used* instead of above medications. Other medications prescribed or over the counter, for back pain or arthritis may need to be discontinued prior to surgery: please discuss with Dr. Kuy.
- O STOP: Birth Control pills, Estrogen pills and/or patches 2 weeks prior to surgery due to added risk of blood clot formation.
- O Do not take Fish Oil, Vitamin E, or any herbal supplements for 10 days before surgery.
- O Any medication taken within a 2-week period prior to surgery, including over-the-counter products, must be approved by Dr. Kuy.
- O Please contact us immediately for instructions if you become ill during the 2-3 weeks prior to surgery, develop a cold, sore throat, fever blisters, and skin eruptions. Minor illnesses or conditions might not prevent surgery from proceeding as scheduled, but we may wish to give you some additional instructions to ensure your rapid recovery.
- O Please **notify us immediately if you should need to postpone your surgery** (at least 3-4 weeks prior) so that we may fill the vacancy in our surgery schedule and reschedule your surgery.
- O Some chemical peel patients: Dr. Kuy will recommend using a skin lightening cream prior to surgery. You will need to pick up Bleacheze cream and begin applying a thin layer every night at bedtime 2-4 weeks **prior** to your scheduled surgery.

O	Chemical peel patients : Dr. Kuy will give you a prescription for an antiviral, Zovirax. Please get these prescriptions filled at your pharmacy and take as directed pre-operatively .	
	One Week Prior to Surgery:	
O	No alcoholic beverages one week prior to surgery.	
O	Avoid overexposure to sun, including use of tanning beds, sun lamps, for at least 1 week prior to surgery.	
O	Facelift and Chemical peel patients: no perm or hair coloring for 5 days prior to surgery and 4 weeks after surgery.	
	Night before Surgery:	
O	Wash operative area with Hibiclens [available at Walgreens]. Do not apply lotions or creams.	
o	If facial surgery: wash hair and face with Hibiclens. No conditioner or hair styling products. No facial moisturizer.	
o	Food intake: Do not eat or drink after midnight prior.	
o	Make up: NO makeup please!	
O	Medications: If you are taking medication for high blood pressure, any cardiac ailment or thyroid medication, you should take your medication as usual, with a small amount of water, morning of surgery or evening prior.	
O	Advance Directives: If you would like to specify a legal surrogate or Durable Power of Attorney for healthcare decisions for the day of surgery, you will need to bring a copy of your legal document to be placed in your chart.	
	Morning of Surgery:	
O	Leave all valuables items, jewelry, wigs, etc. at home. Do not wear a top that goes over your head. Please wear a shirt that buttons or zips in front. We recommend wearing pants with elastic waist, such as athletic wear. Do not wear pantyhose. We suggest tennis or comfortable low shoes and warm socks.	
o	Please bring your daily medications with you on the day of surgery!	
O	Dr. Kuy may send out a biopsy from your surgery. Please bring your Health Insurance Card with you and present to the front desk at surgery check-in.	
o	You may brush your teeth morning of surgery, without swallowing water.	
O	You may receive prescription for medications before you leave office, so please bring insurance card and form of payment for pickup on way home.	
O	If you are scheduled for a facelift , bring a scarf , sunglasses , or other articles to cover your dressings when you leave the surgery center.	
	Post-Surgery:	
O	No driving 24 hours post anesthesia or sedation. Please arrange for family/friend to accompany you and pick you up day of surgery. You will be discharged approximately 1-2 hours after surgery.	
	It is imperative that you are not alone the night of surgery!	
O	If receiving a facelift or full-face chemical peel: You will receive One Complimentary Swiss Medi-Spa treatment: Choose from either a Micro-Chemical Peel with one of our Medical Estheticians or an IPL Laser Spot Treatment with one of our Nurse Practitioners at our office 844-794-7763.
